<u>Appeal 2022 -</u>01 – Stuart Bornstein, 297 North Street, Hyannis MA – Shoestring Properties LP – 110 School Street and 53 South Street, Hyannis

Wayne Kurker, has appealed the decision of the Hyannis Main Street Waterfront Historic District Commission (HMSWHDC) to approve the Applicant's request for a Certificate of Appropriateness for 110 School Street and 53 South

Street (pending 115 School Street), Hyannis as described in the application submitted on February 2, 2022. The HMSWHDC voted to approve the application on February 16, 2022. The Appellant seeks reversal of the HMSWHDC decision or a remand to the HMSWHDC for further proceedings consistent with the Decision of the Appeals Committee. The subject property is located at 110 School Street and 53 South Street, Hyannis, as shown on Assessor's Map 326 as Parcel 121 and 326 as Parcel 125.
